Welcome

Garner sits just south of Raleigh with a genuine hometown feel. It offers a historic downtown, quiet established neighborhoods, newer growth corridors, and practical access to the region.

History

Garner began as a railroad wood-and-water stop before 1870. Downtown developed along Main Street; the historic district is on the National Register. U.S. 70's 1950s bypass shifted commerce outward; recent revitalization has brought energy back to Main Street.

Local Tip: Walk Main Street. The murals, small businesses, and scale of the historic district are a big part of why residents feel attached to the town.
